



## School Supply List 2021-2022

### Kindergarten

- Spill proof/non-breakable water bottle
- 24 count crayons
- Broad tip markers
- Fine tip markers
- Book bag or backpack - needs to fit at least 10" x 13" pages.
- Shoes appropriate for daily gym/recess are needed. No flip flops/crocs.
- Clothing suitable for high activity levels of running, jumping, and even sitting on the floor (such as shorts under skirts & no low rise pants) will be appreciated. No spaghetti strap/t-back shirts.
- The following are for all day students -
  - Small pillow, small blanket - for quiet time
  - Lunch bag

### First Grade

- 12 pencils, rubber banded together
- 1 pkg. Elmers glue

### Second Grade

- 12 No. 2 pencils

- 1 pkg. markers
- 1 pkg. Expo Dry Erase Markers
- 1 single adult cotton sock (for erasing dry erase marker)
- 2 large pink block erasers
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 nonplastic/stiff folders that can stand up when opened
- 1 3-ringed viewbinder, 2 inch
- 1 pkg. of at least 50 3-ringed clear sheet protectors
- 1 pencil box

### **Third Grade**

- Please put name or initials on all supplies.
- Pencils or Erasable pens (dark ink, avoid neon colors)
- 2 Special Writing Pens (To be used for free writing. It can be any color or style, but it should be something that the student enjoys using for extended writing periods.)
- Scissors
- Stick Glue
- 2 Composition Notebooks

### **Fourth Grade**

### **Middle School (Grades 6-8)**

- Pack of post-it notes (3x3)
- 3 small glue sticks
- 1 pack of dry-erase markers

- A quality pencil pouch with three holes

- TI30-xs Calculator (used throughout high school as well)
- Graph paper (no spiral, 4 squares per inch on both sides)
- Sealable and reusable water bottle

#### **Instrumental Music Supply List**

- Clarinets and Saxophones: box of reeds - Rico Blue Box ranging from from 2.5-3.5 size, based on what you played last year. Beginning band - 2.5 reeds, no 2s. Cleaning swab.
- Flutes - cleaning rod and cleaning cloth (can be a piece of old t-shirt). Many flutes come with a cleaning rod already.
- Trumpets, Baritones, French Horns, and Tubas - valve oil and slide grease
- Trombones - Slide oil/lubricant and tuning slide grease.
- Percussion - snare drum sticks (Vic Firth SD1 or any “5A” drumsticks) and a practice pad.
